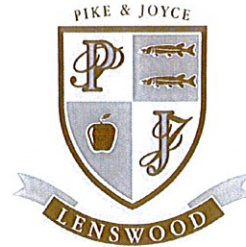


PIKE & JOYCE
ADELAIDE HILLS



2012 PINOT NOIR “W.J.J.” Reserve

Colour: Med to deep red.

Aroma: Complex aromas of ripe dark cherry and strawberry compote along damp foresty notes. The fruit is complemented by just a hint of attractive charry French oak.

Palate: Lush, ripe black cherry and strawberry fruit plus hints of dark chocolate and game. The subtle charry oak and fine tannins add length and backbone to a soft, savoury palate.

Summary: The 3rd Reserve Pinot Noir bottled under the Pike & Joyce label and possibly the best yet. Although drinking nicely even now, we think 3-6 years in the cellar will see the wine evolve into a gorgeously complex classic Adelaide Hills Pinot Noir. Try with beef Bourgogne pie.

TECHNICAL NOTES:

Analysis: 13.5% Alc/Vol; 3.72pH; 6.28 g/L TA.

100% Adelaide Hills fruit. Estate grown single vineyard wine.

Aged in French oak 228L barrels for 12 months.

Closure: Screwcap.
