## **2015 PINOT NOIR “W.J.J.” Reserve**

Colour: Med to deep red.

Aroma: Very attractive aromas of red and dark berry fruits along with some complex foresty notes and a hint of bacony/cherry French oak.

Palate: The palate is chockfull of ripe, dark berry and strawberry compote plus some savoury/gamey notes. Subtle oak, fine tannins and well balanced acidity add length and backbone to the soft, fleshy palate.

Summary: The 4<sup>th</sup> WJJ Reserve Pinot Noir we have bottled and quite possibly the best yet. Although very drinkable even now, we think 3-6 + years in the cellar will see the wine morph into a gorgeously complex classic Adelaide Hills Pinot Noir. Terrific with roast pork.

### **TECHNICAL NOTES:**

Analysis: 13.5% Alc/Vol; 3.49 pH; 5.85 g/L TA.

100% Adelaide Hills fruit. Estate grown single vineyard wine.

Aged in French oak 228L barrels for 12 months.

Closure: Screwcap. 200 x 6p made.
